NexTrex is refreshing its Recycling Challenge! Instead of one opportunity to earn a reward, Trex will now offer quarterly drawings. This means that St. John’s has an opportunity to earn the chance to win rewards up to four times per year.

Twenty-five (25) participating organizations will be randomly selected each quarter and rewarded with a gift valued at \$500. Each winner may select one of the following prizes: a Trex Bench, a Solo Stove, Life-size Jenga, Life-size Connect 4, or a Pop-up Theatre. Every 250 pounds collected is an entry into the drawing. When St. John’s reaches its first 250 pounds in this new challenge, we will receive a gift from Trex valued at \$100.

Creation Care will continue to work collaboratively with St. John’s parish and day school to collect, weigh, record, and deliver single-use plastic film. Please continue to collect single-use plastic and place it in one of the bins at the Historic Church, Resurrection Chapel, or outside of All Saints Hall (ASH). The more we collect, the greater our chances of winning one of the prizes. More importantly, the thousands and thousands of plastic film St. John’s collected last year show how much you honor God’s creation and care for the Earth and its environment.
