or at dawn.*

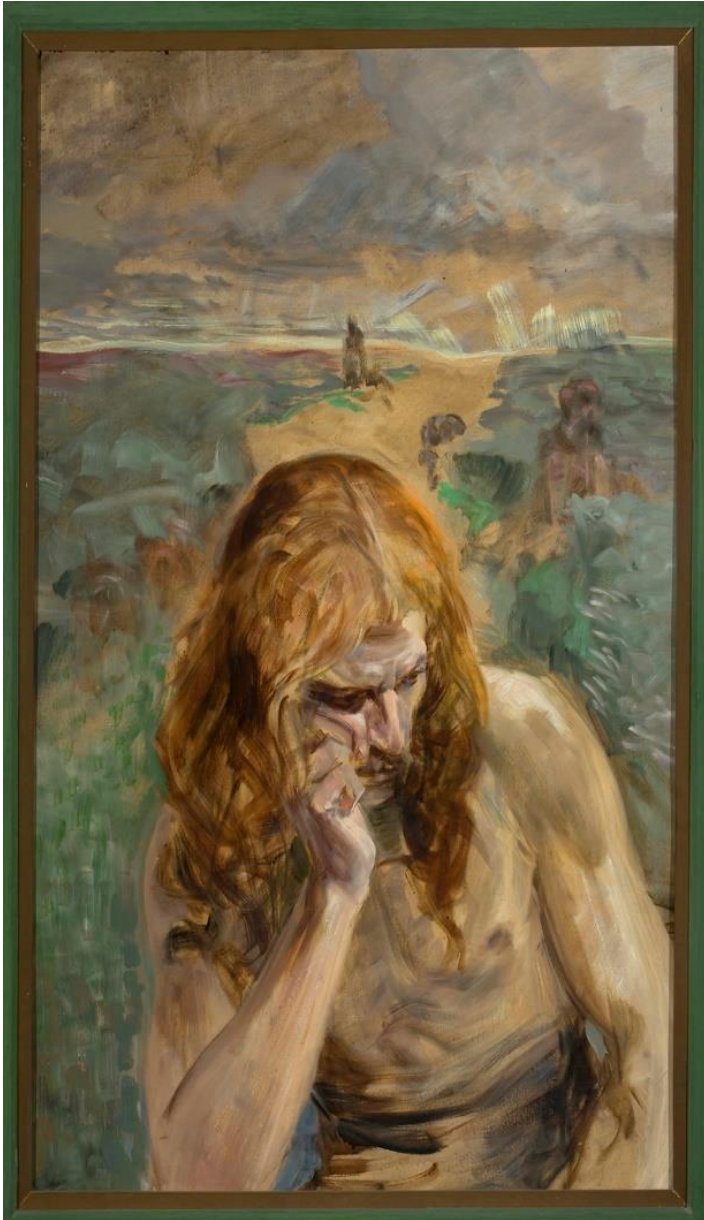

People, look east and sing today:

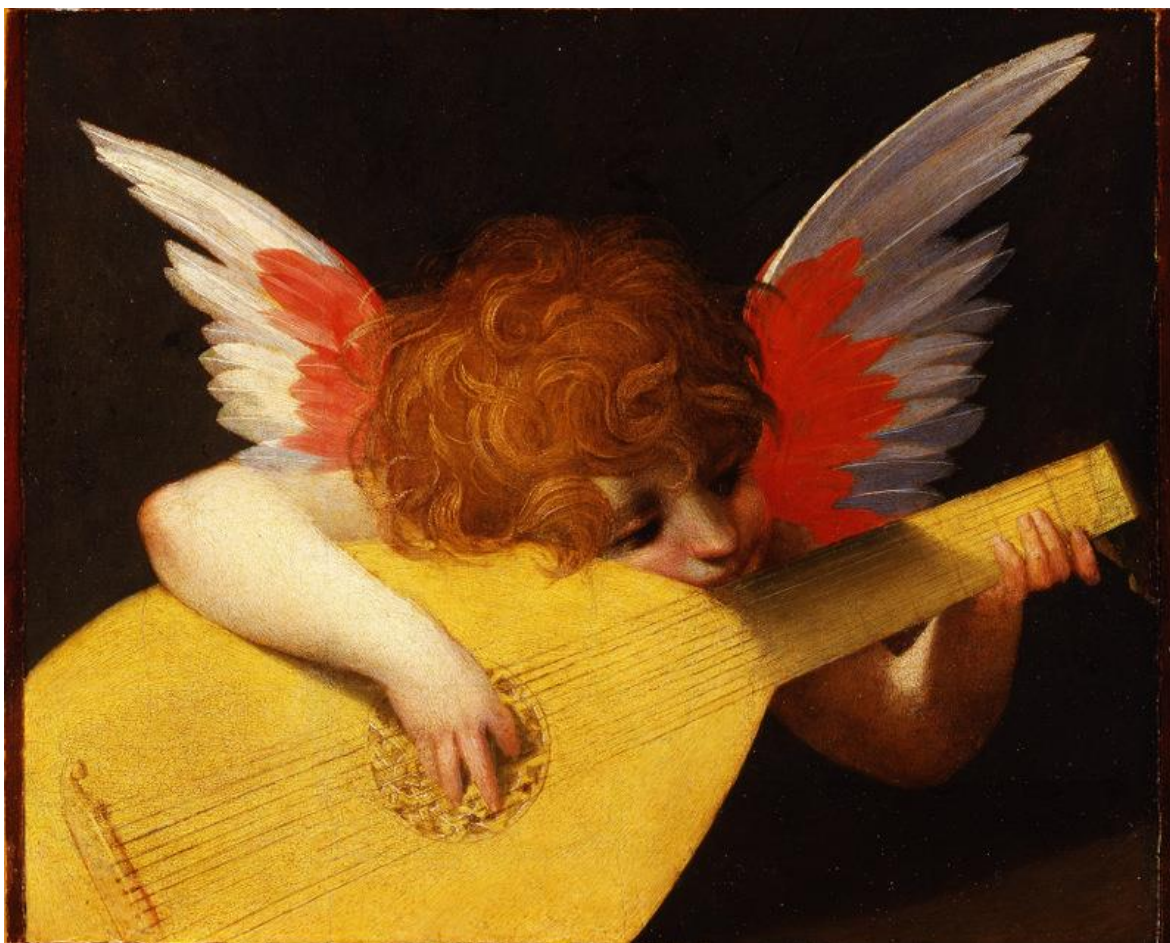
